

# questions TO ASK POTENTIAL DJS

Choosing the right DJ for your wedding is essential for setting the tone and ensuring that your guests have a great time.

## 1. EXPERIENCE AND STYLE

How long have you been a wedding DJ?	
How many weddings do you DJ each year?	
What is your DJ style (interactive, low-key, high-energy)?	
Do you have experience with weddings of our size and at our venue?	
Can you provide references or testimonials from past couples?	

## 2. AVAILABILITY AND BOOKING

Are you available on my wedding date?	
Will you personally be the DJ at our wedding or will it be someone else from your team?	
How far in advance should we book your services?	
Do you have any upcoming events where we can see you perform?	
How many events do you book in one day or weekend?	

### 3. MUSIC SELECTION AND CUSTOMIZATION

How do you curate your playlist for weddings?	
Can we provide a “do not play” list and a list of must-play songs?	
Are you able to take requests from guests during the event?	
How do you handle song requests that might not align with our preferences?	
Can you accommodate specific genres or cultural music requests?	

### 4. EQUIPMENT AND SETUP

What type of equipment do you use, and do you have backups in case of technical issues?	
Do you provide your own sound system and microphones, or does the venue need to supply them?	
Do you offer lighting services, and if so, what options are available?	
How much space do you need for setup, and what are your power requirements?	
Will you visit our venue beforehand to assess the space and acoustics?	

## 5. CEREMONY AND RECEPTION SERVICES

Can you provide music for both the ceremony and reception?	
Will you emcee the event, and what does that entail?	
How do you handle transitions between different parts of the event (ceremony, cocktail hour, dinner, dancing)?	
Do you offer any additional services, such as video projection, photo booths or custom monograms?	
Can you provide audio for speeches, toasts, and other announcements?	

## 6. PRICING AND PACKAGES

What are your rates, and what is included in your standard package?	
Do you offer any package deals, and what additional services do they include?	
Are there any additional fees for travel, setup, or overtime?	
What is your deposit requirement, and when is the final payment due?	
What is your cancellation policy, and are deposits refundable?	

## 7. LOGISTICS AND POLICIES

How do you handle special requests or last-minute changes on the day of the wedding?	
How do you dress for the event, and can you accommodate our dress code?	
How early will you arrive to set up, and how long does setup take?	
What do you need from us or the venue to ensure a smooth setup?	
How do you ensure that the event stays on schedule, and how do you manage the flow of the evening?	

Asking these questions will help you determine whether a DJ service aligns with your vision for your wedding and whether they have the experience and professionalism to make your event a success.
