TO ASK POTENTIAL WEDDING VIDEOGRAPHER

What is your cancellation or rescheduling policy?	
Do you have liability insurance?

Can you provide a detailed contract outlining all terms and conditions?	
What is your policy on sharing our wedding video online or in your portfolio?
